Fees: Registration money goes to pay entertainment and hotel expenses. Believe me, there won't be any money left over because we have to provide all our own entertainment just like they did in the 1860s. But in the remote case money is left after expenses, it will be donated to the Children's Tumor Foundation.

Full Weekend Registration fee: \$25 per reader, \$5 for each family member.
Example: Jill ReaderOrAuthor, husband, and two children would be \$25+\$15=\$40.
Saturday only fee: \$10 per reader, \$2 for each family member.

Example: Jill Local and husband for Saturday only would be \$10+\$2=\$12.

Send payment via PayPal to dianegarland12@gmail.com. Please use the Friends and Family option or else include an extra \$2 for the PayPal service charge.

- You can stay at the **Idaho Hotel!** (Register as soon as possible, please!)
- Or you can camp. If you need assistance to find rental equipment? Chelle Gluch can help you. She'll also let you know where you can camp. There's no charge for the campground but be warned, there are no facilities other than an outhouse.
- Will you bring a western costume? (optional, but please say yes!)
Are you willing to volunteer? (only registrants are eligible to volunteer)

Rooms: Book your hotel room as soon as possible please, because if they're all booked, we get the run of the entire hotel! If no one answers your call, try again later. The owners do all the work themselves so they miss calls sometimes.

Summer months: 208-583-4104.

Winter months: 208-863-4768 (Owner Jerri Nelson's cell phone).

Note: The Murphy address given on the website is no longer valid due to snow damage to the post office, so Jerri will tell you how to send payment for your reservation.

Meals: You can bring your own food (campers might opt to do this) or the Idaho Hotel has a full service restaurant. Believe me, you *want* to try every kind of Jerri's pie!!! And her French onion soup is to die for.

If you have special dietary needs, please inform Jerri (208-863-4768) at least a week, preferably a month, ahead of time (but if you do make a special request, please take advantage of it during your stay). There is no corner grocery store, so if you don't let them know what you need, it won't be available.

The short order restaurant is open except during the hours when Jerri isn't cooking and serving the family-style meal for breakfast and dinner. More on that to come, because believe me, those meals are fabulous. She'll take registration for family-style meals separately.
